2. Cross the road with care and walk past the Newmarket car park and take the track which veers right, running parallel to the houses.

1. From the bus stop turn left up the Falmer Road past the houses until you come to a brideway signpost on your left.

3. Turn left before the aerial, through the gate, and follow the terraced track down into the valley. Follow the path around the valley and, after a gate, follow the tree line until you come to a waymark post at a junction.

4. Walk straight on and follow the brideway which bears around to the right and walk down the track following the fence line on your left.

5. Follow the track as it bends round to the right and join the road up the hill, until you come to a gate on your left.

6. Pass through the gate and follow the brideway towards Balsdean Farm. Continue straight on down the hill. Ignore the brideway on your right. Go straight on down until you eventually come out onto Westmeston Avenue.

8. Walk down Whiteway Lane and at the bottom turn left onto Vicarage Lane which comes out on to the High Street. Cross the road for the bus stop to catch the bus (No. 2 or 2A) back to Woodingdean OR turn left, down to the coast road where there is a bus stop in front of the White Horse pub for buses to Brighton.

7. Turn right onto the track and then take the path leading off the track to the left. Follow the path down which brings you out onto Whiteway Lane.

3. Follow the track past the aerial until you come to the Castle Hill National Nature Reserve on your right. Enter the reserve through the brideway gate adjacent to two field gates and follow the track down through the valley.

4. Exit the reserve through a brideway gate and follow the path to the left around the valley bottom.

5. Pass the disused farm buildings on your right until you come to a path cross roads next to a clump of trees.

2. Cross the road with care and take the left hand fork on the track next to the car park.

6. Take the brideway on the right and follow the track with the tree line to your right.

1. From the bus stop turn left up the Falmer Road past the houses until you come to a brideway post on your left.

7. At the next brideway gate bear right and climb gently around the hill side on the terraced grass track.

8. After climbing the hill, pass through the brideway gate and join the gravel track. Follow this track back to the car park on the Falmer Road.

9. Re-trace your steps back down the Falmer Road to catch the bus opposite the Downs Hotel.

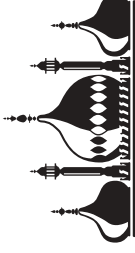

3. Cross the road with care into the car park. Go through the car park and follow the road between the two lodge houses, down the hill. After about 100 metres turn sharp left at the waymark post where you will enter the woods.

4. At the end of the woodland cross the two stiles and follow the hedge line.

5. Go across the next stile just past the dew pond and follow the path through the trees.

2. Go straight across both roundabouts, over the bypass, leaving the road to walk up the embankment and diagonally across the field. Follow the path until you reach the Ditchling road.

6. At High Park Corner turn right following the arrows to Millbank. Past the buildings a flint wall is on your left.

1. From the bus stop follow the road bearing left up the hill to the roundabout at the top.

7. After walking under the electricity wires at Millbank turn right down the hill towards Stanmer village.

8. Once at Stanmer village turn right at the pond and follow the road up the hill. (cafe and toilets in the village). The road will bring you back to the Upper Lodges car park and from there just follow your original route back across the road, through the field, over the bypass and down the hill to the bus stop.

Hope you enjoyed your walk.
