BUS ROUTE 2/22 3. Turn left before the aerial, through the gate, and follow the terraced track down into the valley. Follow the path around the valley and, after a gate, follow the tree line until you come to a waymark post at a junction.

4. Walk straight on and follow the bridleway which bears around to the right and walk down the track following the fence line on your left.

5. Follow the track as it bends round to the right and join the road up the hill, until you come to a gate on your left.

6. Pass through the gate and follow the bridleway towards Balsdean Farm. Continue straight on down the hill. Ignore the bridleway on your right. Go straight on down until you eventually come out onto Westmeston Avenue.




